SUMMER CLIMATE IN CROATIA

Croatia has two climates, as you may well expect – one along the coastline, and one for the interior of the country. Coastal Croatia has warm to hot summers , with July and August being the hottest months. For those planning on enjoying Croatia during the low season, swimming should be in order from mid to late May. For those venturing in the interior, average temperatures in the summer would be around the low 20s $^{\circ}$ C (70°F).

Enjoy the evening relaxing on King Benji, some cocktails and watching the sunset. We will spend the night at anchor.






Wake up and enjoy a beautiful breakfast on the swim platform. We will haul anchor and head to our amazing anchorage in Hvar, stern to the rocks.

This wonderful anchorage has lovely crystal clear waters which is awesome for snorkelling upon your return. We will spend the night in port and have indulge in the nightlife on shore there is the famous Carpe diem nightclub.


A favourite spot for many, this place is awesome. Tucked away in the one of the most memorable anchorages in Croatia. King Benji will tie stern too the rocks.

A day full of fun on the water toys. After an epic lunch at the teppanyaki bar we will do a cruise on the tender/jet skis to go check out the Submarine holding areas.

Enjoy a diving lunch onboard while absorbing the lustrous views.

Dinner at Konoba Porto Rosso on the South Side of the island, indulging in the Lastovo cultural experience.

We will spend the evening here at anchor.





Welcome to one of the best-kept secrets of Croatia. Having only recently become open to foreign yachts, Lastovo Island is still a new addition the Croatian yacht charter itinerary. However, it is quickly set to become popular owing to its incredible scenery and numerous dive sites. Lastovo makes a great place to drop anchor and soak up the sun.

LASTOVO - KORCULA 30nm 3 hours

Early morning departure over to Korcula whilst having breakfast underway. Over here we will spend the days enjoying the water toys. Hobie cats / small sail boat available.

After fun on the water and a day full of activities, we will head into port.

Enjoy a leisurely stroll through the boutique stores and perhaps in the evening indulge in the nightlife this glamorous town has to offer.

Tonight dinner will be at the famous Michelin star restaurant "L.D" . Overnight in port





Activities

Town of Korcula – Visit of the historical sites of the town of Korcula, including the birth house of Marco Polo and various museums.

Entire Island of Korcula – Tour of the entire island, small places scattered around Korcula, each with its own history and charm. Visiting wineries and tasting some of the best wines of Adriatic and Croatia is a must for all the wine lovers.

Moreska - It is one of the oldest traditional European dances still performed, and that records exist of it being danced in Lerida in 1156 in a form portraying a Christian and National victory over the Moors and their expulsion from Aragon. Today, Korcula is the only island where it is still danced with real swords in its original War-Dance form and where it has enjoyed a proud and almost unbroken tradition for over four centuries, though the text, music and pattern of the dance have been slightly altered and shortened (the contest used to last for two hours!) over the years.

A short voyage to one of the most memorable anchorages in Croatia - Mljet. Being tucked away in your own secluded anchorage to really endure lustrous forest and the ocean surroundings.

Being located in this spot is pure tranquility and relaxation at its finest.

If you are feeling active there is a really cool nature walk to the Mljet lakes through the national park.

We will spend the day and night here. The dock for Benji to go for a walk is only 5 minutes away by tender.

Cocktails on the bridge deck, teppanyaki for dinner and a beautiful sunset to be remembered.



Wake up to breakfast on the swimplatform and a morning swim. We will depart after breakfast and make our way along the beautiful Mljet coastline to our new anchorage in Sudurad.

Today we will enjoy exploring the islands before making our way to spectacular Bowa, this place boasts its Bali vibe cabana style relaxation on the rocks at it's finest. Where Game of thrones was shot. Dubrovnik is full of activities, bars and restaurants.



Activities

Game of Thrones – on this tour guests will be taken through all the parts of the Old City where some of the most memorable scenes from the ongoing cultural phenomenon were filmed. Dubrovnik was the official setting for King's Landing – the capital of the Seven Kingdoms realm.

Dubrovnik Old Town – The visitors can walk along almost 2 km long city walls, visit Revelin fortress, Roland's Column, Bell Tower, Sponza Palace and Rector's Palace, as well as Franciscan Monastery.

Trsteno arboretum – it has been protected in 1962 as a monument of garden architecture and a collection of decorative trees and bushes, from both Mediterranean and exotic origin.

Lindo, Dubrovnik - Established in Dubrovnik in 1964, the Lindo Folklore Ensemble is a cultural institution under the auspices of the City of Dubrovnik. It was named after the favorite and best-known folk dance of the Dubrovnik region.

Watermills on River Ljuta – a system of watermills and stamp mills built on river Ljuta, Konavle, which consisted of eight watermills for flour, two watermills for oil and three stamp mills.

Sokol fort - the ruins of the fort have been placed under state protection and are maintained in their present condition.


This morning we will enjoy an early morning swim before heading south to Dubrovnik Old Town area.
